



What export options does MagicPlan design software offer

MagicPlan design software offers a variety of export options for different purposes, including **detailed reports, sketches, 3D models, cost estimates, and statistical data**. The available file formats depend on the type of export you choose. [🔗](#)

Export options by file format

For documents and reports

- **Report PDF:** Generates a PDF file that includes the sketch, photos, notes, details, and any custom forms you have added to the project.
- **Sketch PDF:** Exports a PDF of just your floor plan sketch, including dimensions and details.
- **Statistics CSV/PDF:** Allows you to export project information like surface area and perimeter into a spreadsheet (CSV) or document (PDF) for further analysis.
- **Estimate XLS/PDF:** Provides a cost breakdown of your project in either an Excel file (XLS) or a PDF. [🔗](#)

For 2D sketches and images

- **JPG and PNG:** Standard image file formats for sharing floor plan images.
- **SVG:** A vector image format that allows for scaling without losing quality.
- **DXF:** A format compatible with design software like AutoCAD, though dimensions are not always included in the export. [🔗](#)

For 3D models and BIM

- **OBJ:** A widely used file format for importing 3D models into other 3D design software for continued editing.
- **USDZ:** An augmented reality file format that allows you to view your project in AR by tapping the file in the MagicPlan app.
- **IFC:** A Building Information Modeling (BIM) format for transferring 3D models into other BIM software, like Revit. This option is typically available with higher-tier subscriptions. [🔗](#)

How to export from MagicPlan

Whether you are using the mobile app or the cloud version, the export process is straightforward. 

In the mobile app

1. Open your project from the home screen.
2. Tap the "Export" icon, which looks like a blue export symbol, in the upper right corner.
3. Select the type of export you need (e.g., Report PDF, Sketch Files).
4. If needed, tap "Settings" to customize the export before generating the file. 

In the MagicPlan Cloud

1. Log into your MagicPlan Cloud account and open the project.
2. Click the "Send" button in the upper right corner.
3. Choose your desired export option from the menu.
