

# What export options does pCon.Planner design software offer

pCon.planner offers a wide range of export options for your design data, including 3D models, 2D graphics, images, and commercial information. Some advanced or specialized formats are exclusive to the paid PRO version.

#### Geometry and 3D model exports

The software supports exporting your designs to common 3D formats for use in other CAD and visualization programs: @

AutoCAD: DWG, DXF, and DWT

3D Studio: 3DS

SketchUp: SKP

COLLADA: DAE

Alias Wavefront: OBJ

Autodesk FBX: FBX (PRO version only)

GL Transmission Format (glTF): GLB and glTF (PRO version only)

Industry Foundation Classes (BIM): IFC (PRO version only)

Universal Scene Description: USDZ, USD, USDC, and USDA (PRO version only)

### Image and visual exports

You can save various types of visual output from your design: @

- Static images: JPEG, PNG, TIFF, and BMP formats.
- · 360° panoramas: For immersive views of your project.
- Animations: The ability to create and export videos of your designs.
- Multi-content pictures: Proprietary image files that contain embedded commercial information (PRO version only).
- High Dynamic Range (HDR) images: For professional rendering effects.
- Vector graphics: Export a 2D wireframe view as a scalable vector graphic (SVG) or Enhanced Metafile (EMF).
- Augmented Reality (AR): Use the AR Export function to create an interactive experience for clients via the pCon.box mobile app.

#### Commercial and data exports

pCon.planner allows you to extract important project data for business purposes: @

- Article lists: Export a list of all products in your project as an Excel (.xlsx) or CSV file for pricing and inventory management.
- pCon Exchange Container (PEC): This proprietary format includes both graphical and commercial data for seamless exchange between pCon applications.
- pCon.basket Exchange (OBX): This XML-based format is used for exchanging article data with other pCon programs.
- PDF documents: Create professional documents that include your plan, article lists, and commercial details.

## Other specific exports

- For lighting professionals: Export your lighting information to Relux (.recadz) or save your own custom render styles.
- For Revit users: The PRO version offers a specific Revit Exchange Format (.rgfx) to transfer content to Autodesk Revit.
